The City of Cape Coral is replacing water mains and installing new storm drainage along an approximately 1.2-mile area of Nicholas Parkway East from Santa Barbara Boulevard to Country Club Boulevard. Other improvements consist of installing new curb and gutter and swale work. The roadway pavement will be reconstructed to help motorists better navigate the curves along the parkway.

Early offsite work included constructing storm drainage improvements from Nicholas Parkway East north along SE 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, east on SE 10<sup>th</sup> Terrace, north on SE 1<sup>st</sup> Place, then east between the houses located on the south side of SE 9<sup>th</sup> Terrace and Hunter's Run Golf Club.

## Construction Update

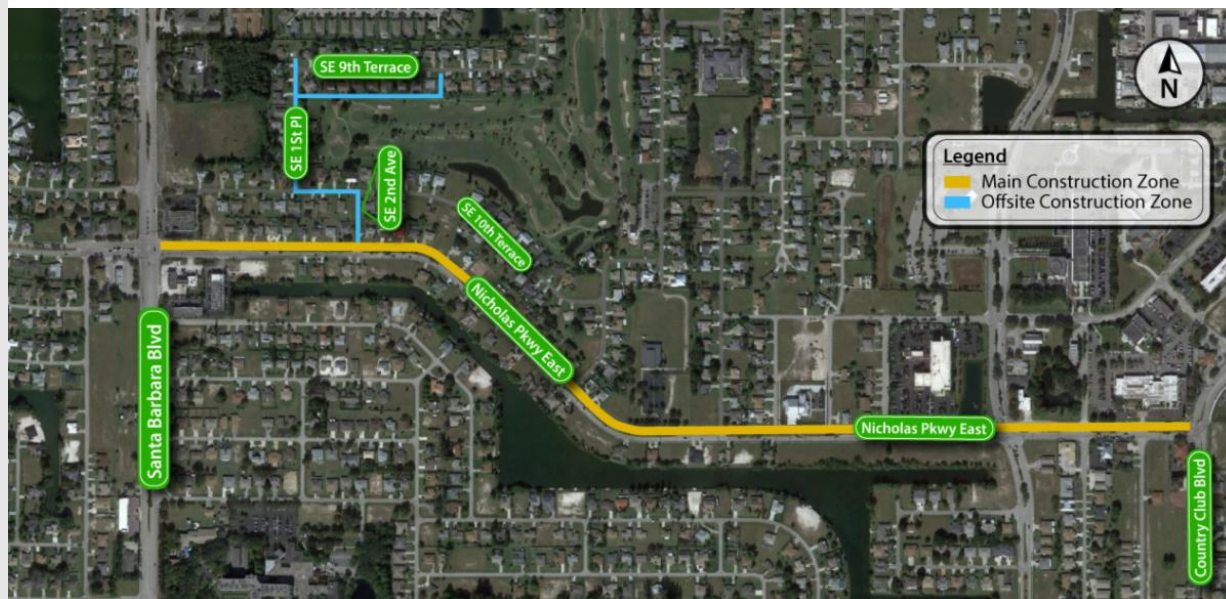
**Nicholas Parkway East** is reduced to one lane in each direction between Santa Barbara Boulevard and Cultural Park/Academy Boulevard while crews make watermain, drainage and sidewalk improvements and rebuild the eastbound roadway.

- Crews are installing storm drainage, trench drain, and guardrail on the south side of Nicholas Parkway East.
- Crews will be continuing right-of-way restoration on the north side of Nicholas Parkway East.
- Motorists should expect lane shifts and intermittent closures.
- Access to the south side of Nicholas Parkway East will be maintained for local residents at SE 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue.
- Residents may need to access their property from a different direction.
- This lane reduction will remain in place until the work is completed.

Survey crews are setting stakes on the south side of Nicholas Parkway East at the locations where storm drain boxes will be installed. These stakes are being pulled up almost as soon as they are set. These stakes are vital to the success of the project and it is costly and time consuming to reschedule the surveyors to come reset them. Please help us maintain these stakes to prevent costly delays and unnecessary expenses.

Drivers, bicyclists, and pedestrians should use caution. This schedule may be subject to change due to inclement weather and unforeseen underground conditions.
